- Western Dental Presentation:
 - Offering \$500/school "Smiles for Schools" Program. Schools can get funds if they partner with Western Dental and invite Western dental to a school event to talk about their program.
 - Western Dental is a for-profit agencies aligned to the Children's Dental Place
 - Western Dental accepts Medi-Cal, offers orthodondics. Uninsured students can pay \$130/year and get 40-60% of their fees paid and get a set of xrays and cleaning at no additional charge.
 - Locations: Sunnyvale and King Road.
 - Interested districts will need to provide a W9.
 - Dagmar has packets.
 - There was discussion after the meeting about Western Dental being a for-profit agency and using schools for advertising. Discussion about not promoting one dental agency over another.
- Avi-Q stock epinephrine
 - \circ $\,$ Monica asked for more information about the Avi-Q stock epinephrine program .

- Rat bite
 - Dagmar shared story about rat bite at school. Learned rats are not tested for rabies.
- Glasses
 - Discussion about where to get low cost/free glasses.
 - Walmart. Store may provide vouchers for free exam and glasses. May charge \$49 for glasses.
 - America's best offers \$50 glasses and free exam. Nurse picks up vouchers.
- Disaster Bags
 - Question about who coordinates school disaster bags. Several nurses reported they maintain bags, but most not involved. . San Jose Unified- Risk Management in charge of bags. Most schools report the PTA at schools pays for supplies.
