Discussion Items

- Bay Coast Fall Conference will be Oct 20th at Michael's Shoreline, Topic: Seizure update and Medical Marijuana
- SNASCC Fall Meeting October 9 at Fiorello's in Santa Clara – topic Stress and the Science of Hope
- Health Concerns lists – Health concerns lists should not be widely distributed - violation of HIPPA/FERPA . Names of students with health concerns should only be given out on a "need to know basis". Students with health concerns should have individualized health care plans.
- Stanford Scoliosis Program – Sunnyvale using Stanford Scoliosis services – One nurse comes to screen the students. Program is easy to coordinate
- New immunization Requirements for 19/20 school year – Public Health Department available for presentations to clarify new immunization requirements. All information can be found on the Shots for School website. Discussion about admitting Homeless/Foster students without immunizations. Homeless students have 30 days to provide proof of immunizations, Foster kids have 2 business days . Pertusis exposure notices are available on the PHD website. Continue to call PHD to report exposure.
- Question to the group about training UAPs for diastat. Most districts training UAPs - SJ Unified has LVN's in the Health Clerk position so they do not need to train UAPs for diastat.
- Jaime Saxena – former School Nurse - now works for Lattitude Food Allergy Care gave a presentation about the services her clinic provides to children with food allergies and the treatment they provide with oral immunotherapies.
