

## **COORDINATOR MEETING**

September 17, 2014 1:30-3:00 PM

**Facilitator:** Dagmar Paul, RN, MSN

**Attendees:** Santa Clara County School Nurse Coordinators/Lead Nurses/Students from San Jose State

The meeting was called to order at 1:32 PM.

**Health and Developmental forms** - Dagmar asked if anyone brought forms as requested by Linda Lenoir. One set of forms was brought in and a copy distributed to everyone. Linda noted that she is especially interested in forms that address mental health.

### **Columbia Neighborhood Center** - Angela Chan

Angela gave a thorough description of the kinds of services offered at the center and who is eligible to receive them. They are located on a school and offer programs, mostly after school hours that include a health clinic, recreational and exercise programs, community education, a food bank and a legal clinic.

### **Stock EpiPens** – Linda Lenoir, Palo Alto Unified School District

Governor Brown signed legislation which will “require school districts, county offices of education and charter schools to provide emergency epinephrine auto-injectors to school nurses and trained personnel who have volunteered...” Discussion followed regarding how to get a prescription for an epinephrine auto-injector, how to obtain and train volunteers and best practice for storage of epinephrine auto-injectors. Copies of the bill were distributed to everyone.

Melinda Landau noted that personnel trained to administer are no longer required to be CPR certified. She also noted that the bill will not take effect until January 1, 2015. She advises everyone to keep track of personnel time to bill to the state.

Linda added that she would like to see 504 plans for epinephrine auto-injectors.

“**Suicide Prevention**”, a presentation by the Santa Clara County Office of Education will be held on October 3<sup>rd</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>. Presenters from Boston Hospital will be present on the 14<sup>th</sup>. Linda Lenoir will send out a flyer and registration information.

Linda Davis-Aldritt has resigned her position as CSNO Executive Director, effective September 30, 2014.

**“Step Up and Be Counted”** Dagmar shared information on the new standardized national data collection program which begins this school year. Six areas will be tracked in every state during this roll-out year. A comprehensive hand-out was given to everyone.

**Public Health Presentation** – Linda Martinez

Pertussis – Notification of a case of pertussis must come from a doctor and must be based on a nasal swab test, not a blood test.

Salmonella is present in the county and is being tracked by the department.

Enterovirus D-68 – Not presently in California, but is now as far west as Utah. Currently 12 states have reported 130 verified cases.

AB 1840 (Campos) Melinda asked everyone to remain current on this vision bill.
